Internationalization

The ULPGC encourages student mobility though programmes such as Erasmus+, which facilities academic exchange and cooperation with the universities around the world.

Facilities and Resources

The ULPGC has modern facilities including laboratories, libraries and sports centres. Students can use advanced technology and access online resources to enrich their learning process.

Cost of Living and Accommodation

Approximate Cost of Living

In Gran Canaria, the cost of living is generally more affordable than in many European cities. The main expenses include accommodation, food, transport and leisure, which can vary depending on the student's lifestyle.

Accommodation Options

Students can choose between university residences, shared flats and private accommodation. The ULPGC offers specific residences, as well as various alternatives in the vicinity, suitable for different budgets and preferences.

Student Counselling Service

The ULPGC offers a guidance service that helps students to make decisions about their academic and personal path, providing advice on the choice of courses.



Psychosocial care

The ULPGC provides psychosocial care to its students, offering psychological support and resources to manage stress and anxiety. This service is designed to help students adapt to university life and ensure their emotional well-being. It also has a university volunteer programme and a programme for students with disabilities.

Work Insertion Programmes

Initiatives are implemented to improve students' employability, including internship opportunities and job counselling. This helps them to acquire job skills and prepare their CVs.

How to Apply

Admission Requirements: To enter the ULPGC, national students must meet requirements such as a secondary school diploma and university entrance exams. International students must submit additional documentation, including official translations of their degrees and, in some cases, language test results.

Application Guide: The application process can be done online. Applicants must first register, complete the application form and upload the required documentation.

Scholarships and Grants: The ULPGC offers various scholarships for students, both national and international. These may include grants for academic excellence, financial need and mobility programmes. The requirements vary according to the type of scholarship, so it is advisable to check the specific information on the university website.

From the south of Gran Canaria



Las Arenas Shopping Centre


Buses 12 and 91 have stops in this shopping centre that connect to iUIBS.
